## Middle School Art Competition

- 1. Artwork will respond to the theme *Mining in Space*.
- 2. Artwork may be 2D, 3D, or you may draw a comic strip/graphic stories with a maximum length of 8 pages.
- 3. In an Artist's Statement, provide information about the size, media, inspiration, and any other relevant information regarding your artwork and the competition theme.
- 4. Artwork will be judged equally on the following four criteria:
  - a. Aesthetics (25 points): Shapes, colors, textures, flow, proportions, composition, etc.
  - b. Inherent meaning (25 points): What is the story or statement?
  - c. Creativity (25 points): Is the artwork creative and original?
  - d. Fulfilled intent (25 points): Does it meet the objective to express something about: "Mining in Space"?
  - e. BONUS (5 points): Scientific Principles: Does the artwork exhibit realistic scenarios, with no obvious breaking of scientific principles or the laws of physics? (Example: Humans in space with no helmets or spacesuit/ body protection, objects on large planets that are unaffected by gravity and float in mid-air, etc.)

## Winner Selection Process

- 1. One Finalist will be chosen from each category. Each finalist will receive a poster of the team and rover.
- 2. Each winning work of art will travel with the team for display at the Team Booth during the week of the competition.

## **Submission Guidelines**

- 1. Artwork will be submitted electronically, via high-quality, centered, in-focus digital photos.
  - a. Artwork will be sent to <u>outreach.blasterbotica@gmail.com</u> in .jpg, .gif, or .png format.
  - b. For 3D artwork, 3 digital photo submissions are allowed, preferably of different views.
  - c. For comic strips or graphic stories, scans and/or photos of the work are allowed in one of the listed formats.
- 2. The Entry Form will be filled out and submitted with the artwork.
- 3. Names WILL NOT be included on any page of the essay, only on the Entry Form.
- 4. Competition runs from January 1, 2014 until March 15, 2014. Submissions must be received by March 15, 2014 to be considered.
